



## Home-School Agreement

At Brackenbury Primary School we want to build a strong partnership between staff, parents and carers as we know this is important in helping children to achieve and to enjoy learning. Our vision statement states...

*"At Brackenbury we nurture the desire and ability to learn so that all of our children have the confidence and skills to be happy and successful in an ever changing world. Our children learn understanding and respect for each other and the community we live in."*

This can be done most effectively when all staff, parents and children understand their responsibilities and work together towards the same goals, as detailed in this Home-School Agreement.

### **The School Will:**

- Provide a broad and balanced education appropriate to the children's needs.
- Provide a safe and secure environment.
- Ensure that all children understand and follow the 3 respects: respect yourself, respect each other and respect our environment.
- Encourage children to reach their maximum potential.
- Set and mark homework on a weekly basis, appropriate to each child's ability.
- Encourage parents and carers to be fully involved in their children's education.
- Assess and provide regular information about each child's achievements.
- Develop and maintain effective two way communication between the school and the family.
- Promote equal opportunities in all aspects of school life.
- Prepare children well for when they move on to secondary school.

### **The Family Will:**

- Ensure their child comes to school every day on time and appropriately dressed.
- Contact the school at the earliest opportunity to explain the reasons for their child's absence.
- Inform the school of any concerns of problems that might affect their child's work or behaviour.
- Provide up to date emergency contact phone numbers and tell the school of any change of address.
- Support the 3 respects: respect yourself, respect each other and respect our environment and follow them when on school premises.
- Attend parents' evenings and other meetings requested by the school.
- Take an active interest in their child's school life.
- Ensure their child completes homework on time and assist them where necessary and possible.

- Support their child so that they can be happy and safe at school.
- Encourage their child to achieve their maximum potential.
- Ensure they are up to date with school news communicated by the school.

**The Child Will:**

- Come to school every day, on time and appropriately dressed.
- Learn to follow the 3 respects and the class charter.
- Have respect for themselves and for all other members of the school community.
- Look after and respect school property, equipment and the environment
- Always work to the best of their ability.
- Do their homework including maths journal and reading on time.
- Ensure that all letters from school reach home safely.

**Together We Will:**

- Give the children their best possible preparation for their future life.
- Give the children the best possible education.
- Ensure the children achieve their maximum potential.
- Ensure the children are happy and safe at school.
- Celebrate the children's and the school's achievements.
- Celebrate the diversity of the school community.
