

**English:**

This half term we will learning how to write:

- simple sentences
- labels and captions
- lists
- simple poems
- simple stories

We will continue to focus on letter formation, punctuation and phonics (letter sounds) to develop reading and writing skills. Children will take part in regular adult-led guided reading sessions.

**Mathematics:**

We will be learning about:

- Reading and writing number sentences
- Place value/tens and units
- Common 2D and 3D shapes
- Making patterns using shapes
- Addition of one-two digit numbers to 20
- Subtraction of one-two digit numbers to 20

We will continue learning to count to 100, practise our number bonds to 5 and 10 and practise writing numbers correctly.

**Foundation:**

**Art/DT:** This half term we will be linking our art to our topic of Remember, remember, making firework images using a range of materials.

**Music:** The children will look at a number of different instruments and discuss the different sounds they make.

**PE:** PE will be on Monday and Thursday for Year 1. We will be playing a variety of team games and activities.

**PSCHE:** We will be learning about personal relationships and the people around us.

**History:** We will be exploring Guy Fawkes and the Gunpowder Plot, asking and answering questions.

**RE:** We will be learning about Christianity, the Church and the Christmas Story.

**French:** Children will learn numbers in French.

**Science:**

This half term we will be learning about everyday materials and will be:

- distinguishing between an object and the material that it is made from
- identifying and naming a variety of everyday materials including: wood, plastic, glass, metal, water, and rock
- describing the simple physical properties of everyday materials
- comparing and grouping materials based on their simple physical properties
